

NOMINATION FOR THE RITCHIE McCLOY AWARD

INTRODUCTION TO THE AWARD

Lisa Boog & Nikki Katz have established the Ritchie McCloy award for CA volunteerism in memory of their father Ritchie McCloy, FCA. This award honours Ritchie's dedication to the integrity of the CA profession as well as his generosity towards numerous charitable organizations.

Presented annually at the ICABC Award Dinner, the Ritchie W. McCloy award will consist of a cash award that will be donated to the recipient's charity of choice.

The Ritchie McCloy award recognizes the contribution of a CA or non-CA to furthering the integrity of the CA profession. The purpose of the Award is to immediately recognize the value of service to the profession, either through a project, a committee, or a series of activities.

Award recipients must also embody the values that defined Richie McCloy's life: openness, honesty, dedication to the CA profession, and integrity.

NOTE:

The Ritchie W. McCloy award for CA volunteerism differs from the ICABC's Community Service Award in its specific recognition of contributions to the profession (rather than all voluntary work with community organizations). It also is meant to provide immediate recognition of a specific service, rather than recognition of decades of ongoing contributions in a multitude of areas. The Ritchie W. McCloy Award is also open to non-CAs.

Award criteria

- Involvement in an initiative that has furthered the integrity of the CA profession on a volunteer basis;
- Recognition of the importance of the contribution of the nominee by two CAs (including ICABC staff);
- Either a member in good standing with the ICABC, or a volunteer with CA-related programs in the past 5 years;
- Known for openness, honesty, integrity and professionalism, commitment to best business practices.
